

Protocol

In alignment with state and local recommendations, Barton College has revised its guidance on attendance at indoor social events.

- 1.) Attendees will not be required to wear masks indoors, but are encouraged to do so.
- 2.) Barton-approved social gatherings will emphasize social distancing of at least 6 feet, which will result in reduced occupancy.
- 3.) Event organizers are required to have their event plans approved in advance, and must monitor compliance with capacity, mask, and social distancing requirements during the duration of the event. The safety plan is to be submitted to the chair of the COVID Workgroup.

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While the chair may request additional information, the submitted plan must include the following:

- a. Social distancing plan (eg, *attendance limit; seat and table spacing*)
 - b. Method of capturing attendance and contact information for attendees
 - c. Location of event
 - d. Name of event organizer(s)
- 4.) When appropriate, social events should be held outside.
 - 5.) Barton College reserves the right to set attendance limits at less than 30% for certain events or venues, and to revisit this policy should state or campus conditions suggest it. Students who participate in events which fall outside these guidelines continue to be subject to campus disciplinary procedures.
