

Protocol

During fall semester 2020, Barton required the use of the daily COVID screening tool (the “Magnus app”) for student athletes, and made it optional for other students. Given the greater prevalence of the coronavirus now, and our need to control any spread among students by immediate contact tracing, Barton College will require all students taking on-campus classes to complete the daily COVID screening during spring semester. That policy begins on the first day of classes, January 19th.

Process

- 1) Students who do not yet have the Magnus health app on their phones should download it. The app is available via Google and Apple by searching “magnus health.”
- 2) Sign in to the app each day, touch the “COVID-19” icon, and complete the screening questions.
- 3) If you receive a green “Go” icon at the end of the screening, you may go to class, eat in the culinary center, etc.
- 4) If you receive a red “Stop” icon at the end of the screening, contact the COVID Nurse Line at 252.668.0858 immediately.
- 5) Instructors will check your screening upon entering each class. If you have a red icon, or you have not completed the screening, you will not be able to enter class.
