***Exemption Option: Praxis Core is waived for the licensure-only program for a person who graduated with a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a 2.70 cumulative grade point average.** Licensure-only students with less than a 2.70 grade point average will be admitted to the Teacher Education Program with a passing score on the Praxis Core Exams (reading, writing, and mathematics) and one of the following conditions: 1) a grade point average of 3.00 in the major field of study, 2) a grade point average of 3.00 on all work completed in the senior year; or 3) a grade point average of 3.00 on a minimum of 15 semester hours of coursework related to licensure and completed during the preceding five years.

***Additional Exemption Options for the Praxis Core Tests:**

Before 3/2016: Total of 1100 for Praxis Core or SAT Math 550 for Math or SAT Verbal 550 for Reading/Writing
 After 3/2016: Total of 1170 for Praxis Core or SAT Math 570 for Praxis Math or SAT evidence-based reading/writing 600 for Praxis Reading/Writing
 OR ACT 24 Composite Score for all or ACT Math 24 for Math or ACT English 24 for Reading/Writing

Note: This program is not offered in GPS. Courses in this program that are required in Elementary or Special Education are offered in GPS, but the other courses are offered only in the traditional program.
