

ALASKA: America's Last Frontier **** (August 24-September 1, 2023). Barton President Doug Searcy and his wife, Beth, will lead this trip. Collette has already promised us 44 spots on this 9-day trip, and we are expecting this to be a complete sellout much like the "Canadian Rockies by Train" trip was back in 2019. So, please do not delay in your decision. There is no cure for Alaska Fever once the last seat is sold! This one has it all. We will arrive in Fairbanks, spend a couple of days there to get our "Alaska legs," then head to Denali. Our first day there we'll have a choice between some pleasant hiking or a wildlife pursuit known to the locals as "shopping." We will spend one entire day in the national park enjoying the scenery and the views of wildlife. We'll check into the iconic Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge, with unforgettable views of the Denali National Park. There will also be opportunities for "flight-seeing" over Denali and the beautiful Alaskan mountains. Later in the week we'll visit a Musk Ox farm, dedicated to saving these woolen mountain creatures. Finally, we head to Anchorage for some time there and a glacier cruise through Prince William Sound, where blue skies collide with stark white glaciers and playful otters dip in and out of the calm waters.
