

Exploring Scotland and Ireland****(May 7-19, 2023). Tentatively, Perry Morrison will lead this trip: We will land in Edinburgh and spend a glorious thirteen days exploring Scotland and Ireland. Once you arrive, you won't have to touch your luggage. In Scotland we'll visit Edinburgh, St. Andrews, Dunkeld, Inverness, Loch Ness, Ballachulish, Glencoe and Oban (for a distillery tour). Before departing Scotland, we'll also visit a lowlands farm and eat lunch with the family that works it. We'll cross the famed Irish Sea on a massive ferry, arriving in Belfast to visit the award-winning Titanic Experience museum. While in Ireland we'll visit the breathtaking Giant's Causeway and the walled city of Derry. We'll also enjoy the 40,000 acres of mountains, lakes and woodlands of Glenveagh National Park in County Donegal, and a guide will give us a tour of Glenveagh Castle. We'll taste cider straight from the farm, then head to Dublin for a tour of one of Europe's most quaint and exciting cities. There may be a pint of Guinness consumed, and we can study the Book of Kells at Trinity College. The price of this trip is \$ 4899, including airfare, transfers and 19 meals.
