



Graduation rates are defined as the total number of individuals from a given cohort of full-time, first-time, degree-seeking undergraduates who complete a degree within a certain amount of time, divided by the entire cohort of full-time, first-time, degree-seeking undergraduates, minus any allowable exclusions.

Using the table above, 40% of the first-time, full-time degree-seeking freshmen who began at Barton College in the Fall of 2017 completed their program by August 2021. Fifty-two percent of this cohort had completed their program by August 2023.
